Teaching duties include math, science, and an interdisciplinary history course. We welcome engaging, high-energy applicants to work primarily with sixth grade students, but with other middle school students as well. Top candidates will have experience teaching math and science to middle school students in an independent school environment. They will also possess a true passion for learning and nurturing growing skills in beginning and advanced students. We expect all candidates will have strong interpersonal skills and an understanding of the developmental needs of early-adolescent girls.
