The candidate should possess at the minimum a Master's Degree in a related field, Ph.D. preferred, and at least 3-5 years of teaching experience at the secondary level or in higher education. In addition, candidates will teach 2 science classes. The Program Head reports to the Dean of Student Research and to the Science Department Head.
