Stone Ridge is seeking an Early Childhood Classroom Aide for our Little Hearts Program to begin August 16, 2017.

Stone Ridge School of the Sacred Heart, a member of the international Network of Sacred Heart Schools, is a Catholic, independent college preparatory school for girls, Grades 1-12, with a co-educational Early Childhood Program (Little Hearts), Pre-Kindergarten, and Kindergarten. With over 700 students and rooted in the *Goals* of Sacred Heart education, Stone Ridge inspires young women to **lead and serve**, through lives of **purpose** that integrate **faith, intellect, community, social action, and personal growth** in an atmosphere of wise freedom.

The Early Childhood Classroom Aide works in conjunction with the Director of Early Childhood and Lead Teachers within the School's Little Hearts Program. S/he provides general supervision and care with children, ages 3 months to 3 years old, in alignment with the Goals and Criteria of Sacred Heart Education. Working closely with colleagues in the Little Hearts Program, s/he facilitates snack and mealtimes, including helping with preparation, feeding, and clean up. S/he assists with diaper changing, room/activities clean up, nap time efforts, and laundry as needed. S/he attends all faculty and employee meetings, as schedule allows, fulfills other faculty duties, and maintains good communication with families as appropriate.

The ideal candidate has experience working with infants or young children in a school/child care setting and must be 16 years of age, or older. S/he demonstrates a record of successful support of children, a capacity for working with a range of learning abilities, and experience with the needs of infants and toddlers. S/he is physically able to attend to the needs of infants and toddlers, with the ability to lift at least 40 pounds regularly.

Compensation includes competitive benefits and salary commensurate with experience.
