

The 2016-2017 Global Girls Inspiration Network will consist of a minimum of ten conversations that address strategic themes with which girls' schools worldwide engage: Leadership; Health, Wellness, & Inclusion; STEAM; Civic & Community Engagement; Classroom Innovation; Strategic School Advancement; Global Competencies; and Teaching & Curriculum. 2015-2016 participants will note some conversations are back by popular demand; others are new for 2016-2017 based on feedback from and emerging needs of schools.

Conversations will consist of one week modules over the course of no more than four weeks. Participants should expect to spend one to two hours per week on each conversation and are encouraged to participate in multiple conversations over the course of the year, one conversation at a time.
